# Autumn Harvest



1. Use a sharp knife to cut the top off of your pumpkin and remove all of the seeds and pulp. Scrape the sides well so that the interior is relatively dry.
2. To transfer the stencil, cut it out of this sheet by cutting around the stencil. Use packing tape to adhere the stencil to the pumpkin and cover the paper entirely with tape. This will help it stay in place and waterproof the paper.
3. Use pumpkin carving tools to carve the apples and pear first, then the leaves. Use a punching tool, skewer, or toothpick to poke the holes.
4. Remove the stencil, place a candle inside, and enjoy!
