YOU CAN NEVER HAVE TOO MANY HOSTAS!

Hostas are one of the most versatile perennials, thriving in part-sun to full shade gardens. They require minimal care, and reward year after year with a beautiful show of attractive foliage in an almost endless variety of shades of green.



Hostas are excellent as garden fillers, for borders, or even with multiple varieties in their own dedicated garden. As they mature into larger plants, they can be split to transplant to fill new spots in your garden in the spring or fall.




LIGHT REQUIREMENTS

Most hostas do best in partial sun or dappled shade but will grow in deep shade. Morning sun will help bring out leaf colouration, especially the golden yellows. Too much sun will cause the leaves to burn.



WATERING GUIDELINES

Newly planted hostas will require daily watering. Once established, hostas are drought-tolerant. If the weather turns hot and dry, increase watering as needed.




SOIL PREFERENCES

Hostas prefer fertile soil. Amend poor soils with compost or manure. They do not like to sit in wet soil, so plant in a well-drained or raised area. Soil should have a pH between slightly acidic and neutral (6.5 to 7.0), although hostas are forgiving.




FERTILIZER

Apply a well-balanced, slow-release fertilizer after planting or when growth emerges in the spring. There is no need to fertilize in the fall.



MULCHING

Apply a layer of mulch around the base of the plant to help retain soil moisture, regulate soil temperature, and reduce weeds. Leave a mulch-free zone around the crown and shoots to prevent rot.



FLOWERING TIME


Depending on the variety, hostas bloom for approximately three weeks between May and September. They send up several long stalks with lavender or white flower buds along its length.




